DIVING IN THE JELLYFISH SEA

daptation is an important part of nature. Prey may change over time to continue the survival of the species, but predators adapt just the same to keep up with their prey. This type of magical evolution is in full display in the waters of Overland.

The Jellyfish Sea is filled with bedazzling jewels that grow in size and value the deeper you go. These gems are shed from the bodies of fantastical jellyfish that make the sea floor their home, and they're as glorious as they

are valuable. But chasing riches too greedily will only pull you into the clutches of this mega predator.

The Haka Jellyfish, or Lunar Princess, is the largest species of jellyfish in the world. Their glowing hoods can reach diameters of 30 feet and their paralyzing tentacles extend up to 50 feet. The Haka grow faceted pink crystals at the base of their bodies, but shed them gradually when they move. When thousands of jellyfish glide as a group, the result is a glittering cascade that fills the deepest parts of the sea with treasure. The shiny gems serve as a lure to the Haka's natural prey (seals, whales, and giant squid), but they've been known to hook ambitious treasure hunters too.

You can see the bounty of this biomagical wonder without getting your ankles wet. Tiny deposits of Haka gems are scattered across the coast like glitter. But with every step away from shore, the hope of something greater pulls you further still. While the SBTC will provide you with the gear to dive as deep as you want, only you can decide how far to press your luck.

So, this adventure offers the greatest

challenge of all: the challenge of will!

Can you keep yourself from being tempted
by the larger and brighter gems in the deeper
seas? It's up to you to prove yourself not just
in skill, but in steadfastness! - WB

If you've got a sweet tooth and a love of splendor, this festival is for you. And if you're coming to the festival, you'd better come on an empty stomach. - WB



Connecting many of the most wild Wonders on the Isle of Brandimir, the Red Way follows a natural belt of magic that spans from coast to coast and beyond. It received its name anciently, owing to the brilliant red mushrooms that dot the rolling hills of the Long Folds. At its height, it was the primary route used by traders to traffic the island's most important magical exports and imports. But in the wilder parts of the island, it's barely more than ruts in the dirt.


Upon your first meeting, you'll find that all representatives of the Caravan are humble,

THE GUARDS OF WHITHAM GATE

ollowing the cataclysm of the Withering War, the world was changed drastically, and to this day many of the traditions and establishments that existed prior to it have been lost, changed, or forgotten. Some ways do not die so easily, however, and at the Whitham Gate, travelers can catch a glimpse of a time nigh-forgotten.

Despite a kindred bond with the kingdom of Withermark, Brandimir was one of the hardest hit during the war. The relentless bombardment of the city of Paisley by the

enemy fleet was a symbolic attack more than a strategic one. After the shelling was done and the warships were gone, all that was left of the former capital were craters and dust. Eventually, the city was rebuilt on top of the ruins, but the central castle was not. The shattered, floating stones of the Gate remain a testament to the resiliency of this great nation and a reminder to never surrender.

Here, despite little more than a floating archway remaining, the Guards continue to watch over what is left of a once fantastic castle. Every noon and every midnight, guests may witness the legendary Changing of the Gate. Like clockwork, armed sentries step down from their posts, marching along invisible steps to and from the gate, to be replaced by a fresh appointment of soldiers.


Some say that the guards have been born with magical powers of flight and levitation, while others believe that they are so devoted to their roles, that they have mastered the ability to walk on the mere memory of the steps that were once there. Nonetheless, the guards are honor-bound to keep watch over the gate, and are meticulous in their duties. As such, whether they are leaving their post or keeping watch, they will refuse to speak

to visitors. We ask that any travelers with the company refrain from pestering the guards; while it will have no effect, doing so would still be quite rude and would be an embarrassment for oneself and the Smoking Bones as a whole. Furthermore, the guards are willing to battle anyone who crosses the line from annoyance to threat.

So, if you're a fan of pomp or moved by history and tradition, the majesty of the ceremony is sure to inspire those with the conviction to preserve the sacred remnants of our history. - WB

THE GREAT FIREFLY HUNT

Velvetine, Brandimir



as the world ever felt too small to you? Too tame? Too safe? Then it's time to embark on what is guaranteed to be your biggest adventure yet: a trek into the Highmoor Woods, where the rodents stand higher than horses and the trees stretch up taller than mountains. Take one step into the woods and you'll find yourself magically shrunk to a size no bigger than an insect, turning what would be an ordinary forest into an opportunity of immense proportions.

In the Highmoor Woods, you'll discover a world abounding with experiences you never thought possible: bounce across patches of giant mushrooms, slip down dew-slick blades of grass into cool streams (beware of fish!), or soar on the winds while clinging to a cluster of dinflower seeds. The whole woods are your playground!

While the Highmoor Woods has much to offer those with a daring sense of adventure, there's one experience sure to thrill folks of every kind: The Great Firefly Hunt. This annual event is a spectator sport to rival all others, known to bring crowds not just from Brandimir, but from all across the Northlands. In fact, you're likely to spot your favorite celebrity in attendance.

During the week-long series of competitions, jockeys ride trained steeds of their choosing (be it mouse, lizard, or, in one case, a bat) in a mad dash to catch the most fireflies with their pole nets. While the arena – much like everything in the woods – is quite large, members of the audience will have the perfect view from grandstands carved high up in the trees. Bringing or buying a pair of binoculars is also recommended. This world-renowned contest is held in honor of the great explorer

Cormish Velt, the first person to both chart the woods and also return to share his knowledge. According to legend, during one particularly perilous night, he managed to lasso three fireflies, which served as both a distraction to predators and a source of light, leading Cormish to safety. In fact, you can still view his tiny lassoes at the Velvetine Museum, as well as some of his early maps and other sketches from the woods.

A word of caution while making travel plans to see The Hunt: even returning fans have been known to get lost on their way and, as Cormish discovered, the woods are no place to go stumbling about in the dark. Luckily, Smoking Bones has you covered. Their partnership with AniTran, the world's best animal transport service, will provide you with an affordable chance to ride along in the painted beetle caravan. You'll arrive in comfort, having enjoyed a few notable stops along the way to view some of the greatest vistas around. For those given to flights of fancy, we recommend AniTran's royal beeline. You'll arrive on time and in style, with a complementary honeycomb platter. - AL

In the end, the Highmoor Woods is one big adventure you won't soon forget.

HYDE PEAK WIND HARVESTING

Verdant, Brandimir



hile the wind engine was the milder magic invention of the millennium, it couldn't function without the magical winds harvested in the remote areas of the Northlands. High on the mountaintops, only accessible by the strongest of airships, Hyde Peak Wind Harvesting has staked its claim.

Not much is known about the winds of Hyde Peak and the magical properties that cause them to persist when all other winds would die. But one thing is sure: this kind of power is rare. It takes grit and a stout heart to collect it.

"Wild" wind can be collected in multiple isolated locations in the Northlands, but the Hyde Peak Co. has stationed itself at the apex of a veritable wild wind whirlpool in the Verdant Mountains, making it one of the most iconic and most profitable harvesters in the business. Their signature sled-like mills and bright balloons are the hallmarks of an entire industry.

Though the process of collecting, refining, and shipping wind is fascinating in its entirety, it's the "baggers" that get most of the attention. Starting from the top of a harvester mill, baggers ascend long wires tethered to the ballons above. As they climb, they check the status of special bags collecting wind along the line. When a bag has reached its full capacity, it is disconnected from the tether and replaced. Then, with agility and grace (and nerves of steel), the bagger uses the filled bag to free fall down to the base of the mill, where the refining stage begins.

There's so much to take in at Hyde Peak!
Witness the harvesting in person as baggers

rise and fall as they capture and tame the magical winds. Or explore the factory itself, where magical wind is refined into a solid and packaged for export. Or, for the truly adventurous, try your hand at harvesting. What you catch, you keep! - WB

Travel Company is the only provider of civilian tours for this location. Access to restricted areas is limited; some areas (e.g. factory floor, wind balcony) can only be entered during scheduled tours, and further sections of Hyde Peak are completely prohibited.



A standard wind bag, about the size of an adult man, is able to harvest up to sixteen Swells (sw) of wind.



The Hyde Peak Wind Harvesting Company has been around since the introduction of the wind engine itself. Because the raw wind they collect is already of a superior quality, their refined and packaged exports consistently receive Grade A ratings or better.



Fire water, like that found in Tipton, can be harvested and refined into a source of energy, but it's an ancient magical fuel. It's only used in its milder form among more traditional communities in the Northlands.

THE FIRE SPRINGS OF TIPTON

Thornwatch, Brandimir



s an adventurer with the Smoking Bones Travel Company, you can expect all manner of amazing experiences throughout your journey. Some are calm and relaxing days at peaceful resorts, while others are upbeat and exciting ventures in exotic locales. But for those who really want to feel the heat of intensity both metaphorical and literal - you will find your daring encounter with danger here at the Fire Springs of Tipton.

At the highest plateau of the Tipton

Mountains, lies a huge network of craters and waterfalls flowing with boiling fire water. You have undoubtedly seen this enchanted substance in many places as a source of fuel, but here, the fire water is untamed and vicious - glowing in harsh, vibrant reds and yellows - bubbling ferociously, as though it were magma with a barely-hidden temper.

In fact, the people who lived here in ancient times thought that the souls of the dead came here to leave their anger behind before passing on to the next life. Some might call it superstition or even a fairy tale, but those who have long studied the springs know just how much the springs abhor the living.

And yet, despite this, the springs are home to some of the most beautiful wildlife imaginable. The beautiful origami trees take root along the fire water's edge. They seem barren and take on a dark gray hue, indistinguishable from the rocks around them, but once day breaks, their leaves unfold from their branches to take in the sunlight. And speaking of rocks, be wary of which ones you pick up; you may find yourself holding a newly awoken (and likely unhappy) pumice toad! Their size, texture, and static nature may seem like mere camouflage at first

glance, but this is also how they've adapted to the fire water over many years. Adventurers can even see them floating on the water, catching the metallic steelflies that foolishly flit too close.

Despite the hostile environment, the Fire Springs are filled with a vibrancy obvious to anyone with the eyes to see it. - WB

For your own safety, please remain on the designated paths. The springs are hot enough to cause burns just from putting one's hand over them, and falling in will kill a human within seconds. Furthermore. please be wary of the wildlife. It's not wise to agitate animals capable of surviving volcanic temperatures.

THE GAZE OF THE CHIU ORACLE

here are a great many places where people go to seek enlightenment or answers. But between science, magic, and superstition, none are as clear or as accurate as the Chiu Oracle.

The Chiu Oracle is located high in the Chiu Mountains, a small trio of peaks in the greater Hornwood Mountain range, surrounded by ice and snow. The Oracle itself is a roughly carved, monolithic head, shaped to look like an old man, wizened and beaten by the wear and tear of the world.

Once a month, when the full moon is at its zenith, this stoic, stone sage begins to hum. In this state, the Chiu Oracle is ready to impart its mysteries and those brave enough to touch the Oracle are quickly overwhelmed with visions, voices, and promptings leading to knowledge and insight, both deep and intimate. The Oracle does not tell the future, but impresses upon the mind personal truths that are often too subtle or revelatory to grasp unaided. The wisdom it bestows is neither good nor bad, but simply correct. And not all who find themselves under the penetrating gaze of the Oracle's eyes are ready for the secrets it unlocks.

The Oracle is beyond ancient and not much is known about how the Oracle was sculpted into its current form. Legend has it that Cressida III, the ancient queen of Luminivera discovered the unsculpted, humming rock and relocated her royal residence to a small hovel nearby so she could gleen as much as she could. She disbanded all of her advisors and hired expert craftsmen to mold the truth-telling stone into the form of her long-dead father. Eventually, she abandoned her kingdom without a care and dedicated her life to the pursuit of greater self-realization. Fact or fiction, the story rings true to all who

have experienced the gaze of the Chiu Oracle themselves.

And now it's your turn. While an SBTC tour will get you close to the Oracle, the last mile must be traversed by foot...and it's not easy. But, upon reaching the summit, most people feel like the trek was preparing them for what was to come. In that exhausted, humbled state, truthseekers are ready to comprehend the unknowable and ponder the unthinkable.
